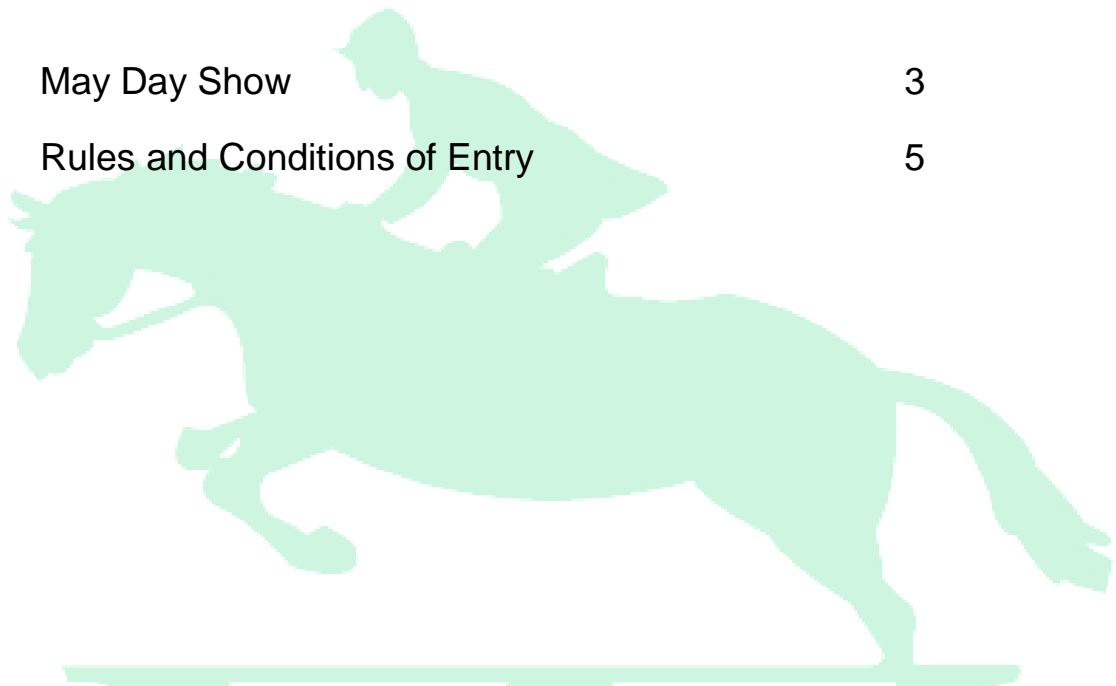

9.00am Start – Ring 1 (Clear Round)

A round for every showjumper to enjoy and warm up
Rosettes for each Clear Round – £4 per round

10.00am Start – Big G Cleaning Ring 3 (Showjumping Classes)

'All aspects of cleaning covered'

Class 1 Bottom Hole Pole

True beginners. Riders can be led.

Class 2 Starterstakes (1'6" – 1'9")

True beginners. Rider not to have been placed 1st in a Minimus Class or above.

Class 3 Minimus (2' – 2'3")

No restrictions.

Split horse/pony

Class 4 Novice (2'3" – 2'6")

No restrictions. Split into horse/pony

Class 5 Michael John Dole Memorial Cup - Teams

Teams of 3 riders each jumping different heights – 1 rider must be of Minimus standard. Course heights 2', 2'3", 2'6"

Class 6 Intermediate (2'6" – 2'9")

No restrictions

Class 7 Open (2'9" – 3')

No restrictions

10.30am Start – Bluewater Self Storage Ring 2 (Riding Classes)

‘Secure quality self-storage at affordable prices’

Class 8 Working Hunter Pony 2” – 2’3”

50% ride, 40% jump, 10% manners

Rider expected to ride a short display

Class 9 Working Hunter Horse 2’3” – 2’9”

50% ride, 40% jump, 10% manners

Rider expected to ride a short display

Class 10 Best Riding Horse/Pony

To be judged on conformation, condition & manners

Rider expected to ride a short display (no jumping)

May be split into horse/pony depending on entries

Class 11 Best Rider

Rider expected to ride a short display with small optional jump.

May be split into Junior/Senior depending on entries.

Class 12 Best Ridden Coloured

Open to all coloureds – spotty, tricolour, skewbald, piebald and palomino. Judged on Conformation, Manners and Suitability as a riding horse.

10.30am Start – Horseshoe Barn Ring 4 (In Hand Classes)

‘A Beautiful Barn to hire in Bexley in a unique rural location’

Class 13 Lead Rein

Open to children 12 years & under who are not yet confident to ride on their own. Rider expected to show rising & sitting trot.

Class 14 Young Handler In Hand

Children 12 years & under. May be assisted. 50% manners, 40% turnout, 10% confirmation.

Class 15 Handsome Gelding

No restrictions

Class 16 Prettiest Mare

No restrictions

Class 17 In Hand

Handler to be over 12 years. 50% manners, 40% turnout, 10% confirmation.

Entries

Advance entries close 5pm Friday 4th May 2018

Entry Fee

£8 advance £10 on the day plus £3 First Aid

Riding School £65 exclusive advance only event hire, including one class entry – additional class entries as for non-riding school above.

Prizes

Rosettes 1st – 6th and trophies 1st – 3rd in every class

Class 4 Michael John Dole Memorial Cup to winning team and £150.00 prize money. Winners' names are engraved on the roll of the cup. Cup remains on display in Mount Mascall Stables Clubroom.

Ground

Grass arenas (weather permitting), indoor provision in the event of inclement conditions.

Rules

Please note individual ring start times.

Class 1 & 2 Timed, Class 3 & 4 Two phase, Class 5 Jump off, Classes 6 & 7 Two phase, Classes 8 & 9 Judge may ride.

Classes 8, 9, 10, 11 & 12 display rides should be approximately 2 minutes duration.

Rules and Conditions of Entry

- All competitions are unaffiliated. Dressage and Showjumping classes are run in accordance with the relevant governing body; British Dressage or British Showjumping. Check each event for additional competition rules.
- Correct attire to be worn at all times when competing, appropriate to discipline.
- When mounted it is compulsory to wear a securely fastened hard hat to a minimum standard PAS 015 with Kitemark/equivalent. For XC strictly skull caps only. Absolutely no peaks, except on silks.
- Whips – appropriate to discipline & not exceeding 30cm for jump classes. Whips must be carried and used correctly. Misuse will result in elimination.
- Equines must be correctly tacked for their competition. In hand entries may be presented in a riding or in hand bridle.
- Equines must be four years old and over. Age to be taken from the 1st January.
- Horse = above 14.2hh. Pony = 14.2hh and below. Combination = Horse/Pony & Rider. Senior Rider = 16 years and over. Junior Rider = under 16 years. For series entries, age is taken as at start of series.
- Stallions will not be permitted without advance notification and acceptance in writing from the organiser.
- Equines must have passports and current and up to date vaccination against tetanus and flu.
- Equines must not be left unattended if tied to horse boxes or trailers. Fences must not be used.
- No galloping at any time anywhere on the premises, except if requested by the judge for Working Hunter.
- Numbers in the warm-up arena may be restricted. Please check with the Secretary/Steward.
- Show rings and warm-up arenas must be exited at walk only.
- Entry fees are per rider per class/test unless otherwise stated. Advance entry recommended to enjoy the benefits of discounted fees. On the day surcharge is £2 per class. Please complete entry forms with care and legibly with appropriate fee enclosed.
- First Aid & Arena Team charge, £3 per rider per event.
- HC entries welcome. Remember it is very bad etiquette and you may be disqualified if you enter below your level and do not declare HC.
- Entries are accepted in order of receipt.
- Withdrawals and refunds: Riders who withdraw BEFORE the close of entries and provide a veterinary or doctor's certificate will have 50% of their entry fee refunded or transferred to a later show. NO REFUNDS will be made to those who withdraw AFTER the close of entries.
- Prize monies must be collected on the day by close of event from the Entries Secretary or forfeited. Annually awarded trophies must be returned to Mount Mascall Stables on time - damages/loss will be charged.
- Smoking is not permitted anywhere other than in designated smoking areas.

Rules and Conditions of Entry (Continued)

- Well behaved dogs on leads are welcome at all our events. Some areas are out of bounds and entry can be refused without reason. Please pick up after your dog.
- Please take your litter home or use the bins provided and remove any droppings or hay from the car park before leaving.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to a competitor and to cancel or alter any event/class without giving a reason.
- Any objections must be lodged with the Entries Secretary in writing with a fee of £25 within 10 minutes of the class ending. The fee will be returned only if the objection is upheld.
- The decision of the judge and/or organiser is FINAL.
- Please follow any instructions or requests from staff and observe all notices on the premises.
- Neither the organisers nor any person acting on their behalf accepts any liability for loss, damage, accident or injury or illness to equines, riders and spectators or any other person, vehicle or property whatsoever.
- All riders and equines must have current Third Party Liability Insurance.
- Failure to comply with rules and regulations will result in disqualification.

Additional Rules and Conditions of Entry for Riding School Entries

- Mount Mascall Stables Riding School horses & ponies are available for hire for all events.
- Refer to each competition for fees and special arrangements/conditions that may apply.
- Withdrawals and refunds in the case of riders apply as for non-riding school entries. Riders who withdraw BEFORE the close of entries and provide a doctor's certificate will have 50% of their entry fee refunded or transferred to a later show.
- In the case of a riding school horse/pony becoming unavailable for any reason an alternative will be offered. If this is before close of entries, riders will have 50% of their entry fee refunded or transferred to a later show if they do not wish to ride the alternative equine.
- NO REFUNDS will be made to those who withdraw for any reason AFTER the close of entries.
- J W Equestrian Ltd may refuse an entry request without reason and reserves the right to limit additional class entries and withdraw any equine at any time in the case of safety & welfare of that equine.
